BETHESDA NORTH OB/GYN CLINIC

Funding for 3 blood pressure cuffs each month for uninsured patients to check and keep a log of blood pressure at home and funding for Hispanic Gestational Diabetes support.

PERINATAL PROGRAMS

A grant to cover the yearly partnership fee with New Life Furniture and to pay for the delivery of furniture - beds, sofas, tables, etc. for families in need.

BETHESDA NORTH PERINATAL PROGRAM

In the sad case of infant loss, the Special Care Nursery uses Preshand Inserts to provide a respectful and dignified manner for transportation to mortuary care.

\$1,700

SPECIAL CARE NURSERY

The Special Care Nursery volunteers make quilts for babies who are in their care for more than 3 days. They also keep a small number of car seats for babies whose families cannot afford to purchase their own.

OPERATION SMART - Strategic Medical Asset Readiness Training

Provides welcome meals and items for service members who come to Bethesda North for direct medical skills training. Grant will provide support for the program again this year.

TRIHEALTH CANCER INSTITUTE

Presented us with information about Genetic Counseling for Pancreatic Cancer Patients. Grant to cover out of pocket costs associated with genetic testing. This testing can direct oncologists to newly approved targeted therapies and educate patients on inherited cancer risks.

TRIHEALTH CANCER INSTITUTE

Funding for Psychosocial Oncology Indigent Patient Basic Needs. We are granting funds for Kroger gift cards that can be used for food, medication, and gas to/from appointments for oncology patients in financial need.

Thanks to information obtained during Administrative Review, the group was able to find Tablets that were no longer being used at TriHealth – a savings of \$3,000! Funding for 3 sets of needs:

- Replacement of 3 Documentation Carts
- Refurbishment of 12 Treatment Tables
- Sitting Bench Outside the Physical Therapy Clinic
