\$5 per pay (the cost of a latte) or \$130*...

\$10 per pay (the cost of a mobile app) or \$260*...
provides 4 day's stay at a shelter for a victim of domestic violence.

\$20 per pay (the cost of a pair of movie tickets) or \$520*...
