



Bethesda Lyceum Supports the Thomas Heart & Vascular Center



Last Thursday evening, a sold-out crowd of nearly 500 supporters of the Bethesda Foundation and Bethesda North Hospital came together to celebrate the 23rd annual Bethesda Lyceum. Hosted at the Hard Rock Casino, the event raised *more than \$225,000*, which will support the continued development of the Harold & Eugenia Thomas Heart & Vascular Center on the campus of Bethesda North Hospital – the region's destination for the most advanced heart, vascular, and thoracic care *anywhere*.

One powerful example of how our fundraising programs are making a real difference for the patients we serve can be found in our **Mechanical Circulatory Support and LVAD program**. During last week's Lyceum, we shared the inspiring story of one patient's journey – **Kathy Akintobi**. Suffering from advanced heart failure, Kathy turned to the TriHealth Heart & Vascular Institute Team at Bethesda North for care. Left with virtually no other clinical options, the team of cardiologists, cardiac surgeons, intensivists, and many others successfully implanted a left ventricular assist device (LVAD) that gave Kathy a new lease on life. Kathy's story was shared and celebrated at the Lyceum, which you can watch in this brief video.
